- 1. This application is to be used to apply for and have recognized a training course for which the learning objectives have been met by completion of formal training courses conducted by another jurisdiction outside of Pennsylvania or for a Non-Local Level Training course conducted in PA. This form is for training courses only, not certification.
- 2. The application must be completed, please provide ALL of the following. The information being requested is needed to verify that the out-of-state OR Non-Local Level PA course is indeed substantially equivalent to its Pennsylvania counterpart
  - a. Use the correct PA course names. For detailed information on a specific course, review the Academy website for the "Minimum Standards for Accreditation" (MSA) for the course you think is equivalent.
  - b. Your course completion certificate;

- 4. Criteria for approval of an out-of-state or Non-Local Level course as equivalent:
  - a. The total number of student contact hours must be substantially (no more than 10% less) the same as its Pennsylvania counterpart; and
  - b. The time spent on each subject area must be substantially (no more than 25% less) the same as the time spent on the same subject area in its Pennsylvania equivalent; and
  - c. The course objectives must be a substantial match (in learning outcomes) to its Pennsylvania equivalent.
- 5. If rejected, an applicant may reapply after correcting the identified deficiencies.
